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Classroom Leader Job Description

Camp Hope Horizon is a six- week, summer day-camp program for Elementary and Middle School students in East Palo Alto. Both Elementary & Middle School students in rising 1st through 9th grade will receive academic support, engage in exciting STEM and art projects, fun games, character building, weekly outings with a host of other nonacademic programming. Camp Hope Horizon will run Monday through Friday, from 9:00 am – 3:15 pm.

Job Description:

- Oversee and provide instruction for a classroom that includes up to ten - twelve students and is possibly aided by a high school intern or a Hope Horizon volunteer.
- Be available to learn curriculum, instructional delivery and meet deadlines pertaining to the program.
- Ensure you are meeting the program goals within the program implementation.
- Follow the professional development guidelines in delivering the project-based curriculum during the six-week program.
- Provide guidance to the interns and or volunteers in tutoring, mentoring and leading group activities to reinforce the goals of the program.
- Provide & implement behavioral interventions for students from training.
- Attend and encourage students and their families to participate in the “show case” end of program celebration event.
- Communicate with Program Manager and or Assistant Director of Programs regarding student concerns, progress, or any other program concerns.
- Agree to and apply all Hope Horizon EPA policies and procedures given to ensure safety of staff, students, and volunteers.
- Agree to safety policy and procedures related to Covid-19
