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High School Internship Description

Camp Hope Horizon is a six- week, summer day-camp program for 75 Elementary and Middle School students in East Palo Alto. Both Elementary & Middle School students in rising 1st through 9th grade will receive academic support, engage in exciting STEM and art projects, fun games, character building, weekly outings with a host of other nonacademic programming. Camp Hope Horizon will run Monday through Friday, from 9:00 am – 3:15 pm.

Job Description:

- Assist classroom leaders, instructors, and session facilitators by leading group activities, tutoring and mentoring.
- Be available to learn curriculum, instructional delivery and meet deadlines pertaining to the program.
- Facilitate and lead Camp Hope Horizon sessions if needed
- Build a working relationship with other interns and Camp Hope Horizon staff.
- Assist in the End-of-Program showcase hosting parents and families of students
- Assist in preparing building and classrooms for Camp Hope Horizon prior to program start.
- Assist in cleaning and organizing facilities after program end.
- Provide & implement learned behavioral practices from training week and beyond.
- Communicate with Program Manager and or Assistant Director of Programs regarding student concerns, progress, or any other program concerns.
- Agree and apply all Hope Horizon policy and procedures given to ensure safety of staff, students, and volunteers.
- Agree to safety policy and procedures related to Covid-19
